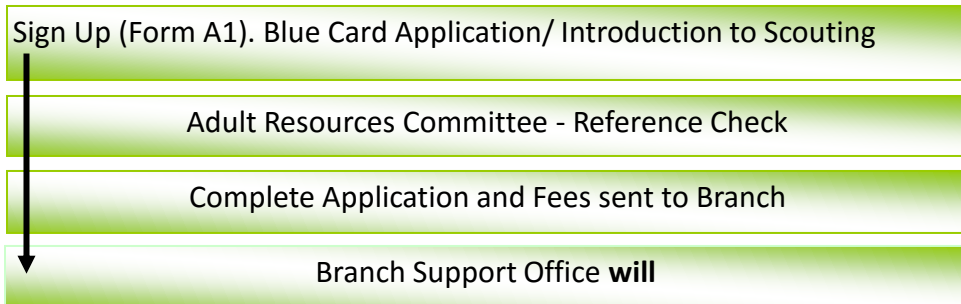




Basic Wood Badge completed within 12 months of joining the Association

Must take all completed attachments to the course

Verify Performance with Team Leader

4 months after attendance of the Advanced Course undertake the Wood Badge Assessment with your District or Region Commissioner
